CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. All entries must be from members of the Association.
- 2. All entries must be received by the Auctioneers <u>NOT LATER THAN WEDNESDAY 30TH JULY</u> 2025 AND DEFINITELY NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- 3. Indication on the entry form must be made if your flock is Maedi Visna Accredited & Scrapie Genotyped.
- 4. <u>Numbering</u> Neck number tags will be issued to breeders on arrival and all sheep must be numbered with their respective lot number before inspection.
- 5. Tagging: ALL sheep must be tagged in accordance with DEFRA & BWMSBA regulations.
- 6. <u>Inspection:</u> Vendors should not remove sheep from the vehicle until the inspector is present and gives full permission. On arrival at the sale ground, <u>all sheep</u> will be inspected by Official Inspectors. <u>Full Mouth Ewes</u> are to be sound in tooth and udder. The Association Inspectors will check for obvious faults, breed points, and infectious disease, but buyers should ensure the soundness of the sheep before purchase as the animal will become their sole responsibility at the fall of the hammer. Inspections are carried out without prejudice to either the Inspectors or the Association.
 - 6.1 If any animal within a vendor's consignment shows signs of infectious diseases, ALL of the vendor's entries will be rejected and must be removed from the market premises.
- 7. Members are specially cautioned not to send to the Market any animals suffering from an eruptive condition of the skin, orf or orf-like lesions.
- 8. <u>Stock not entered for Show & Sale:</u> Stock additional to those officially entered must not be unloaded and will not be permitted to be sold on the sale ground in the official sale or by private arrangement.
- 9. <u>Export:</u> Responsibility of stock being suitable for export, <u>or other regulations</u>, remains the entire responsibility of the seller and purchaser.
- 10. <u>Order of Sale:</u> All sheep will be sold in guineas (105p) and in strict catalogue order. A ballot for order of sale will take place at the Auctioneer's Offices for entries in each class. Pens of more than 2, but up to 5 females in each age category will be sold at the end of each section. All Rams will be sold in rounds.
- 11. The Champion Male and Champion Female exhibits must be offered for sale and if not sold, the Vendor shall pay full commission on the reserve price given to the Auctioneer.
- 12. The Chief Steward has authority to change, alter or amend any regulations/conditions if circumstances demand, and has authority of arbitration over all events on the day.

PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded to Sixth Place in Classes 1 - 7, along with **The R.A.E.** Herbert Trophy - for Best Male Exhibit, and The Peter Jones Trophy - for Best Female Exhibit.

The 'A.S.R. Austin' Perpetual Challenge Trophy and the 'J. Straker, Chadwick & Sons' Points Championship Cash Prize of £20 will be awarded to the Exhibitor gaining the highest number of points in the Show (this is to be calculated using a points system of 1-6 for 1^{st} to 6^{th} prizes in Livestock Classes 1-7.

CHARGES

- 1. A Commission of 5% is payable to the Auctioneers.
- 2. A Levy of 2.5% payable to the Breeders' Association.
- 3. A Toll of 10p per Head.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF SALE

- 1. <u>Responsibility for Stock:</u> The Sheep are the responsibility of the seller up to the time of sale. It is the responsibility of the seller to present the sheep in the sale ring. At the fall of the hammer, the sheep become the responsibility of the purchaser.
- 2. Ram Lambs are bought as seen and approved.
- 3. <u>Shearling & Older Rams</u> are guaranteed fertile by the seller. In case of dispute later, it is a matter between the seller and the purchaser.
- 4. <u>Female Sheep</u> shall be guaranteed empty at time of sale unless stated otherwise.
- 5. <u>Minimum Selling Price:</u> Senior Rams 70gns; Shearling Rams 150 guineas; Ram Lambs 100 Guineas.
- 6. <u>Private Selling</u> is not permitted. All sales must go through the Auctioneers.
- 7. All Sheep must be accompanied by the appropriate movement licence required at the time of sale and must be tagged in accordance with the new rules for breeding sheep and comply with all other regulations in force at the time.
- 8. <u>Scrapie Genotypes</u>: Scrapie testing is now voluntary, but members are welcome to announce results in the ring if they wish.

Animals may be presented for inspection from 7 - 9.00am on the day of sale. Vendors are expected to make the effort to arrive in good time. If you are held up "en route" please inform the BWMSBA Secretary (Dot Tyne 07511 653715) as soon as possible.
